## we are faith-based

Rollin Stierwalt moved to Wesley Homes Lea Hill soon after it opened. A retired United Methodist Minister, he knows many of the residents at Wesley Homes Des Moines. “There are more clergy at Wesley Homes in Des Moines than ever,” he stated. “Some of them gave me static for moving to Lea Hill and not Des Moines.”

Rollin was alone after his wife died in 2004. “It was a major struggle for me living without her.” The

community at Lea Hill provides a home where neighbors are around and help in case of an emergency. Lea Hill is also close to Kent United Methodist Church where Rollin leads a Bible study and sings in the choir. “The interaction with people is one of the great satisfactions of living here,” says Rollin. “Chaplain Norm Lawson even invites me to give the sermon at Vespers once in a while. I was happily surprised when he also gave me a free meal ticket.”

Waldron & Company, a Seattle-based management consultancy, was engaged to help identify the common elements of Wesley Homes' culture. The goal is to establish procedures for replicating our culture as new communities and programs are added to Wesley Homes' network of services.

During the culture study, key indicators were identified through discussions with members of the Board of Trustees, results from the resident survey, staff interviews and manager workgroups. These indicators demonstrate the strengths of the organization and will help guide new programs in 2009.

### WE HAVE A GOOD REPUTATION IN THE COMMUNITY

Ever since Rev. Dr. Stanley Logan started his campaign to build Wesley Gardens in 1944, the community has come together in a grass-roots effort to support his vision of serving older adults. Today, the vision is the same and the Wesley Homes name stands for stability, community and quality care. Other care providers, church members and community leaders look to Wesley Homes for best practices and services. Wesley Homes Community Health Services helps expand Wesley Homes' reputation through the delivery of home care services to clients in King, Pierce and Snohomish counties.

New residents often come to Wesley Homes because someone told them about it or they knew someone who lived here. With such a strong referral base, advertising expenses were low and occupancies remained high in 2008. For the year, Wesley Homes Lea Hill reached a 96% occupancy rate, Wesley Homes Des Moines maintained 97% and Wesley Homes Health Center was steady at 95%.

## we are a community

Missionaries for much of their lives, Paul and Lee Lee Castor lived mostly in Malaysia and the eastern United States. They moved to the Pacific Northwest when their son told them, "Your grandchildren are growing up without you."

Their first experience with Wesley Homes was on a Sunday. A staff member met Paul and Lee Lee at church and spent the afternoon with them at Wesley Homes Des Moines showing them around and talking about their options. "I never dreamed of living in a place like this," says Paul. "It is such a gift for us."

Paul has found a home in the Art Corner at The Terrace. "It has become a point of contact for people here," says Paul. "People walk through all the time to see what others are doing." Lee Lee has been a camera person for the resident TV station, Channel 28, with the responsibility of filming programs in The Terrace. "I have the best seat in the house because I can zoom in," Lee Lee says.

In June, Paul and Lee Lee celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary with family and friends at Wesley Homes. "We had over 80 people come to our party," Lee Lee reported. "Our family loves to come here. They know we're safe and surrounded by friends."

## we are philanthropic

Clem and Koreyne Simpson have lived at Wesley Homes Des Moines for over 30 years and have been giving to Wesley Homes Foundation for the last 20 of them. "We were the youngest people on campus when we moved in," says Clem. They picked the lot and floor plan for the new duplex where they would live. A bird watcher, Koreyne added, "We picked the lot with all the trees and had over 50 kinds of birds over the 21 years we lived there."

The primary reason Clem and Koreyne chose Wesley Homes was for its continuing care promise. "I was impressed

by the fact that people are cared for if they run out of money," said Clem, a retired professor from Whitworth College. With experience developing the Whitworth Foundation, Clem was helpful in the development of the Wesley Homes Foundation. The Simpsons continue to support the Foundation through gifts in honor or memory of people they've known well. "We're really sold on Charitable Gift Annuities, too," he adds. "With the uncertainties of life and income, they allow you to have a regular income while making a gift at the same time."

Through home health, Wesley Homes is able to build its reputation throughout the region. Wesley Homes Community Health Services continues to grow with offices in three other not-for-profit retirement communities in Seattle and Tacoma, as well as through strong relationships with other health care providers.

Wesley Homes' reputation is just as important to philanthropic success. In 2008, Wesley Homes Foundation celebrated an increase in the number of supporters and received four bequests totaling over \$800,000.

### WE PROVIDE HIGH QUALITY CARE AND SERVICES

In its first full year of operation, Wesley Homes At Home received the 2008 HomeCare Elite merit award. This ground-breaking review names the Medicare-certified agencies whose performance measures in quality outcomes, quality improvement and financial performance are among the top 25% of providers in the country. The 2008 HomeCare Elite was compiled using publicly available data from Home Health Compare and the CMS cost reports. "It is an honor to receive this distinction," says Ginny Kenyon, Interim Director for Wesley Homes Community Health Services. "I am proud of our home care staff and the work that they do to serve our clients."

Also in its first year of operation, Wesley Homes Lea Hill had a deficiency-free survey from the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) when they examined the care and services provided in The Arbor memory care area. "This is a great accomplishment," said Scott Hulet, Campus Administrator. "Our staff works hard and really cares about our residents."

An on-going process, the quality of care at Wesley Homes Health Center is measured annually by the Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS). Last year's survey results reflected quality care with only a few minor deficiencies unrelated to resident care.

## we value our employees at all levels: leaders, managers, front-line staff

When you enter The Terrace, Rose Ignacio is often around to greet you with a smile and “Hello.” In her 16 years of housekeeping at Wesley Homes Des Moines, Rose has worked in all three buildings. A stint in the laundry didn’t last long, “I was too short for the sheets,” she laughs. “When I took them out of the dryer, they dragged on the ground.” Rose believes that teamwork, employee involvement and on-going education are important to Wesley Homes’ future. “We have to encourage more staff to be involved and learn about

aging. As we are more knowledgeable, we have a wider horizon.”

Asked about the current financial environment, she answered, “This crisis won’t bother us if we are all involved. Our attitude as staff, when new families come in, is important to bringing in more residents. If we show that we are a happy place, they will want to live here.”

“Residents are my top priority,” Rose concludes. “We are a family and we try to help each other.”

### WE ARE RESIDENT, CLIENT AND COMMUNITY FOCUSED

Over the past year, the staff at Wesley Homes Health Center has been exploring ways to deliver more personalized care to residents. “We’ve tried to be more sensitive to each resident’s individual needs,” says Sheila McDonough, Director of Nursing. “Residents see the same staff each day which allows us to get to know our residents better.” Health Center staff members are also working on how to customize residents’ living environments and meal programs.

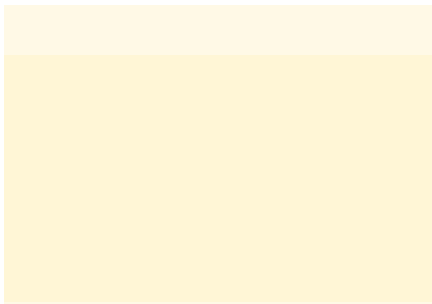
Resident councils continue to be active at each campus, working with management to ensure a high quality of life for all residents. Channel 28 is a resident-run TV station on the Des Moines campus. Over 40 volunteers produce 33% of the programming shown on Channel 28. “It has been an exciting year for us,” says Joan Zatloukal, Station Manager. “Funding from the Resident Councils allowed us to get additional equipment and training in lighting, editing and camera use.” In 2008, the Channel 28 crew produced their first off-campus interview and filming of the Tent City. Residents are now working on a documentary on the history of Wesley Homes.

### WE HAVE A HOME-LIKE ATMOSPHERE

The dining experience throughout our network has been and continues to be a focus for Wesley Homes. In 2008, each campus was able to have its own Executive Chef. Chuck Chalfant elated residents at Wesley Homes Des Moines when he started the popular “Egg Bar” during the week. “We can order eggs any way we like them,” said Terrace resident, Berta Hamby. “The omelets are just wonderful!”

At Wesley Homes Lea Hill in Auburn, David Beall joined the culinary staff and has been raising the level of the dining experience every day. Lea Hill residents Jeanne and Darrell

Brookman recently wrote of their dining experience: “Not only was the Steak Oscar excellent—tender and medium rare as we ordered—but the entire meal was a delightful fine dining experience. The presentation was so pleasing, down to the chocolate-dipped strawberry garnish—and Sarah and Tanya added to our pleasure as our attentive servers.”

In the coming year, the Wesley Homes culinary team plans to change the way food is delivered at the Health Center. “We’ll be remodeling our dining areas and hiring wait staff to serve our residents in the care center,” said Mark Gustafson, Campus Administrator. “We want to get away from serving on trays and become more home-like and personal.”

### WE ARE NOT-FOR-PROFIT

As a not-for-profit organization, Wesley Homes believes in its responsibility to give back to the greater community. Resident assistance programs like the Circle of Concern, Lea Hill Resident Assistance, Bishop McConnell Scholarship and partnerships with other not-for-profits are central to Wesley Homes’ social accountability efforts. In 2008, Wesley Homes Foundation supported 11 residents through resident assistance funds when their finances were depleted through no fault of their own and 18 residents participated in the Bishop McConnell Scholarship program. The Employee Assistance Fund helped twenty-five employees with educational and emergency grants.

New in 2008, Wesley Homes Lea Hill collaborated with the Children’s Therapy Center to provide a specialized aquatics program with therapists for developmentally disabled children. Classes meet for four hours each week in 12-week segments using the campus’ indoor pool. Over ten students participate in each segment from Auburn, Kent and Renton. “When we were approached with this opportunity, residents overwhelmingly supported it,” said Scott Hulet, Campus Administrator. “We are grateful to be able to give back to our greater community through this partnership with another not-for-profit.”

Our partnership with Elder and Adult Day Services is on-going and serves 15-22 clients each day at their center on the Des Moines campus. Also housed on the Des Moines campus, the Pacific Northwest Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church is a supportive partner and helpful neighbor.

### CONCLUSION

Wesley Homes is committed to its mission to serve older adults. Looking to the future, Wesley Homes is in a strong position to advance its mission by creating new communities and expanding important services for the rapidly increasing senior population throughout the Puget Sound region. ■
